

Gujo Hachiman

Mountain town that is famous for its Gujo Odori dance summer tradition with a history of over 400 years. There are many canals along the streets, creating a unique atmosphere.

 The Gujo Odori dance is held every year from mid-July to early September.
 **All-night dancing is held from August 13 to 16.





Hida Takayama

A city with a very quaint atmosphere and many unique restaurants and souvenir shops.

Matsumoto-jo castle

One of the rare castles in Japan that have been designated a national treasure.

- ●Open every day except the year-end (December 29 to 31).
- Regular seasons: 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
 **Admission closes at 4:30 p.m.
 (8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. during Golden Week and the summer holidays *Admission closes at 5:30 p.m.)





Hida Furukawa

A charming town with many old-style buildings. You can walk along the canal where carp swim.

 The Furukawa Festival that is registered to UNESCO's Intangible Cultural Heritage list is held every year on April 19 and 20.





Tateyama Kurobe Alpen Route

Traverse the mountains that are around 3,000 meters high in various vehicles.

 Closed: December to April 9 (opens partially at the beginning of April and fully by mid-April)
 *Open every day during the on-season *Some buildings may close on certain days, depending on the building.





Shirakawa-go

The farming landscape that is one of Japan's most well-known and is registered as a world heritage site is breathtaking in its beauty.

- Shirakawago light-up display: Certain days from late January to min-February.
- •Admission is restricted due to traffic congestion, and you may be unable to tour the grounds.







Okuhida Bear's Park MAP-P5(Shinhirayu -onsen erea)

See about 100 bears including Asian black bears and brown bears. In addition to twice daily bear shows, many people love having their photo taken with baby bears.

- Open period: Open all year round
- Opening hours: 8:00 to 17:00
- Regular holidays: none
- ●Admission fee:1,100 yen for an adult、600 yen for a child
- *A discount of 10% applies to group guests of 25 people or more.





Hirayu Otaki MAP-P4(Hirayu onsen erea)

This massive waterfall has a 64 meter drop and is 6 meters wide. It is one of Japan's most famous waterfalls. You can go on a guided trek. The waterfall freezes in winter, creating a magical beauty. XViewing is free of charge. You can walk right up to the waterfall basin.

- About 15 minutes on foot from "Otakiguchi•Camp-jo-mae bus stop(Numbering H36)"
- •A winter limited event will be held here (please see page 14 for details)





Shinsui-Park MAP-P5(Shinhirayu- onsen erea)

One corner of the park is dedicated to the matchmaker god and is a popular spot for couples. Enjoy an invigorating walk while listening to the sounds of the river. Be sure to walk through the illuminated tunnel under the river.

- ●No admission fee. When coming by car, park at the community center nearby and walk
- from there. (About a 3-minute walk from the community center) Special events are held here in the winter (see page 14 for details).





Hirayu Minzokukan (Hirayu Folk Museum)

MAP-P4(Hirayu onsen erea)

Resource center with a thatched delta roof. Inside, there is an open hearth where the old style of living is reconstructed and old farming tools on display. You can also enjoy the hot springs and meals (changes by season).

- Open period: Open 365 days a year
- Opening hours: 6:00 21:00 (Winter Season: 8:00 19:00)
- Regular holidays: None
- Admission Fee: Free
- •Bathing Fee: Donation (about 300 yen)





Hida Great Limestone Cave "Hida Dai-Syonyudo"

MAP-P4(Nyukawa city erea)

Tourist limestone cave midway between Hida-Takayama and the Okuhida Hot Spring Village that is the highest such cave in Japan (Nyukawa-cho, Takayama city). Enjoy a mystical 800-meter long walk through a cave.

- Open period: Open 365 days
- Opening hours: From Apr. to Oct.: 8:00 to 17:00 From Nov. to Mar.: 9:00 to 16:00
- Regular holidays: none
- ●Admission fee:1,100 yen for an adult,550 yen for a child
- *Group rates (20 people or more) :900 yen for an adult,350 yen for a child
- ₩When coming by public bus, get off at Shonyudo-guchi bus stop. Take the shuttle bus from the bus stop to the limestone cave (phone: 0577-79-2211).





Mukashibanashi-no-sato Gohei-mochi Town Isurugi-no-yu(Public bath), Fukuji Kaseki-kan (Fossil Museum)

MAP-P5(Fukuji onsen erea)

Enjoy eating a meal while sitting around an open hearth. The attached Fukuji fossil museum has a display of the many fossils that have been discovered in the Fukuji hot spring area. (Admission: free)

- Open period: From 27th Dec. to 31th Mar.
- Opening hours:10:00 to 17:00 (Summer Season),10:00 to 16:00 (Winter Season)
- Regular holidays: Wednesday (and an extra holiday)

[Public bath "Isurugi-no-yu"] Bathing fee: 500 yen for an adult, 300 yen for an child
